# Duke University Directory of Buildings

The Duke Directory of Buildings is a pictorial index of the major buildings on campus. It is intended to serve as a guide to basic building facts at Duke University.

The booklet is organized as a timeline of the building and renovation work on the Duke Campus; the buildings are listed in order from newest to oldest. Buildings that have undergone a major renovation are listed in the year that the renovation work was completed and not the date of original construction.

While the Office of Horace Trumbauer, is solely responsible for the Gothic and Georgian core of Duke’s campuses, there have also been over 70 other architectural firms working to make Duke a functional and beautiful campus. The directory contains over 200 building entries. Buildings that were designed and constructed as Trinity College are so noted.

The directory includes an index of design firms, an alphabetical list of building by name, and sustainability certification level.

The entries are organized per the following format and example.

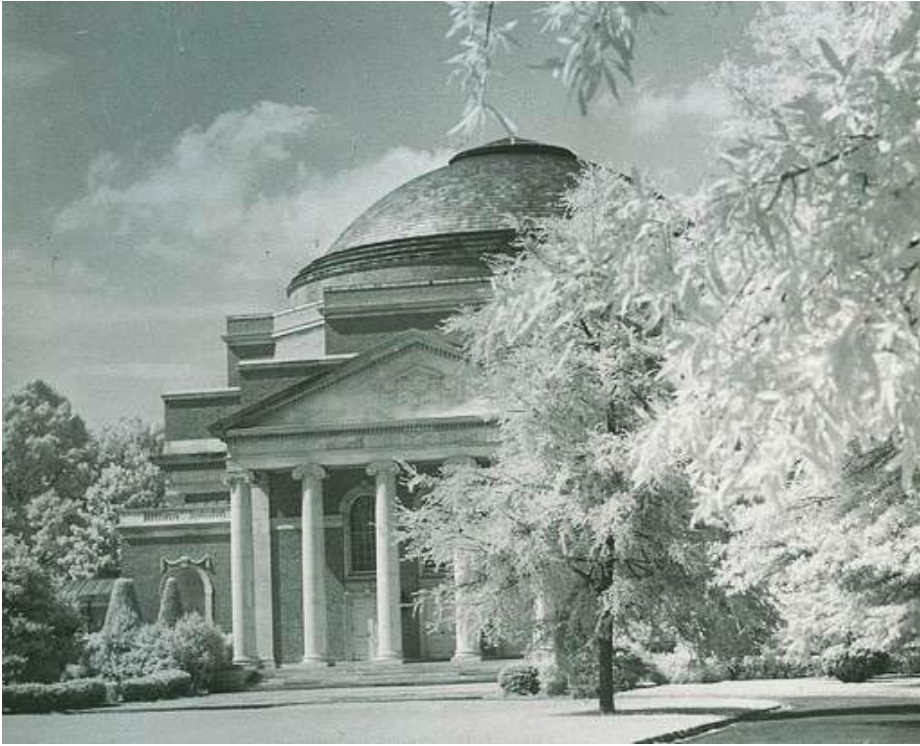

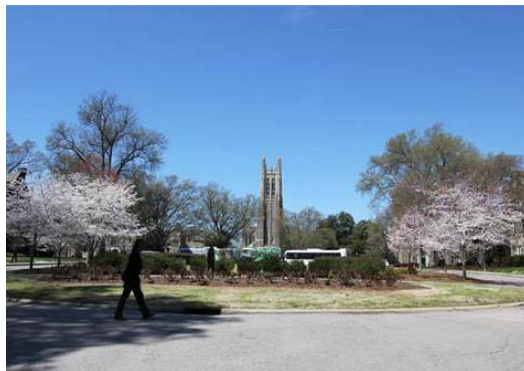
# Duke University Directory of Designed Landscape Spaces

As with the Directory of Buildings, this is an inventory of designed open spaces on Duke's campus. It is not comprehensive to all landscapes on campus but, rather, a composite of those deemed most significant from both a design and functional perspective.

Since the Olmsted Brothers firm designed the East and West Campus Quadrangles in the 1920s, Duke has evolved as a collection of memorable landscapes and open spaces that tie together the buildings created during various eras of design. This section reflects a timeline depicting the evolution of the campus over the decades, during which dozens of landscape architectural firms from across the country contributed to the designed landscape we see today.

The spaces listed here are indicated on the locator map (page 14) and will be updated over time as landscapes are added and/or restored on campus.
