1. Introduction

- A. This Construction and Design standard covers Project Record Documents for CAD/BIM Forms and Guidelines to be used in conjunction with all digital design projects. Related specification sections may include but are not limited to:

- C. Design Consultants and contractors responsible for projects at Duke must adhere to all applicable building codes and the Duke University CAD/BIM Standards. As such all consultants, service providers, vendors and contractors are to follow all applicable Duke University CAD/BIM Forms and Guidelines.
